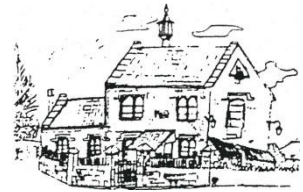

The PFA bedtime reading last Friday was a great success with over 30 children in attendance. Thank you to everyone involved in organising and reading.




New Green Heating Systems!
